I cannot trust everything I see online as some things can be out of date, inaccurate or not entirely true.



Tell a trusted adult if something or someone ever makes you feel upset, worried or confused. This could be if you or someone I know is being bullied online. There are lots of people who will be able to help like my teachers, parents or carers.
