How will we try to protect you?

What are your rights?

You have the right to be safe.
You have the right to speak out and be heard.
You have the right to get help when you need it.

Tell someone if someone is:

- Bullying you
- Saying things to you that upset you or make you feel uncomfortable
- Touching you
- Hitting or hurting you
- Sending unkind messages on the internet or phone

Who can you talk to?

If you are worried about something you can talk to any adult in school. If you tell that trusted adult, they won't be able to keep it a secret and will need to report it to the headteacher.
