Dear Families,

I am writing to inform you about an exciting event we will be hosting to launch our Four Purposes. This event will be taking place on Thursday 18th September. On this occasion, we will be celebrating our 'Superhero Day,' during which pupils will have the opportunity to dress as one of our Four Purpose superheroes. This event aims to engage our students in a fun and interactive manner while reinforcing the values we hold dear in our educational journey.

The Four Purpose superheroes are as follows:

1. **Healthy Banana Man** – Representing health, fruit, and fitness. Outfit ideas include a yellow T-shirt and leggings, a green hat or headband, and optional fruit stickers. A toy dumbbell or skipping rope can also add a fun touch.
2. **Ambitious Amber** – Symbolising dreams, goals, and positivity. Pupils can wear a bright orange or amber-coloured top, adorned with star stickers or badges, and a homemade medal or trophy. A clipboard can serve to indicate planning for the future, while a “Future Leader” sash can be a wonderful DIY addition.
3. **Enterprising Rimus** – Reflecting creativity, business, and problem-solving. Suggested attire would include a smart shirt and tie, along with a homemade name badge. Props such as a cardboard laptop or calculator could enhance the outfit, alongside optional reading glasses to complete the 'thinker' appearance.
4. **Ethical Ernest** – Emphasising kindness, fairness, and environmental awareness. This superhero can be depicted through green or earth-tone clothing, recycling symbols, and a reusable bag. A cardboard sign stating “Be Kind” or “Save the Planet” and a toy animal or plant would further highlight the ethical theme.

On the day of the event, Mr Westcott will introduce each character during the assembly. Following this, pupils will partake in a variety of engaging activities throughout the day, all linked to our Four Purposes.
